

Kalene (Kah-LAY-nee) Mission Hospital is a 160 bed facility in the far NW corner of Zambia, approx 20km from the borders of Angola and DR Congo. It comes under the umbrella of the Christian Brethren, and has drawn missionaries from various countries, including UK, Australia, NZ, USA, and Canada.

We are currently able to offer services in the following areas: general medicine (incl. TB & HIV), surgery, obstetrics, outpatients, pharmacy, xray, ultrasound, basic laboratory testing. We have four main inpatient departments - maternity, female, male and paediatric (with a malnutrition wing). Although we have had no permanent expatriate doctor since early 2013, we have been supplied with medical staff through government channels for varying lengths of time.

Over the last 3 years, it has become clear to the mission staff and hospital administrative staff that Kalene Mission Hospital remains in need of some long-term ex-patriate medical staff to provide a level of stability to the hospital. However, shortand medium-term visits would also be welcome.
